**ORDER**

No 770 – I.S.S/ 2M-15/19

Dated, Howrah, 18<sup>th</sup> June, 2022

Whereas reports and request has been received from the Addl. Director General & Inspector General of Police (Law & Order) , West Bengal vide Memo no. 359/ADGP(L&O)/22 dated 17.06.2022 that in view of the recent events in some areas , Internet transmissions and Voice over Internet Telephony may be used for spreading rumour for unlawful activities in geographical area of Beldanga II Community Development Block covering Rejinagar Police Station and Shaktipur Police Station under Murshidabad Police District ( Revenue District: Murshidabad) over-the next few days;

And whereas, report, also received from the District Magistrate, Murshidabad vide No. 53/C dated 17/06/2022 apprehend deterioration of Law & Order in the event of internet transmission is allowed to remain active in the area aforementioned.

And whereas, examination of the information received gives reason to believe that such unlawful activities are likely to occur in the absence of preventive measures;

And whereas, the Constitution of India guarantees freedom of expression of Indian Citizens but at the same time allows for reasonable restrictions on the same;

And whereas, no restriction is being imposed on voice calls and SMS and on newspapers, hence communication and dissemination of knowledge and information is not stopped in any way;

Now therefore in order to prevent obstruction, annoyance or injury to any person lawfully employed, or danger to human life, health or safety, or a disturbance of the public tranquillity, or a riot or an affray, through an order under Sec. 5(2) of The Indian Telegraph Act, 1885 read with sub-rule 2(1) of Temporary Suspension of Telecom Services (Public Emergency or Public Service) Rules, 2017 and sub-rule 2(A) of Temporary Suspension of Telecom Services(Amendment) Rules, 2020 it is promulgated that:

Any data related message or class of messages to or from any person or class of persons relating to any particular subject, brought for transmission by or transmitted or received by any telegraph within the ambit of the India Telegraph Act, 1885, shall temporarily not be transmitted in the interest of maintaining public order and preventing incitement to the commission of any offence within the geographical area of Beldanga II Community Development Block covering Rejinagar Police Station and Shaktipur Police Station under Murshidabad Police District ( Revenue District: Murshidabad). This order shall come into force 0600 Hrs. from today, 18<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 (Saturday) and shall remain valid till 0600 hours of 20<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 (Monday).
